Reward offered for missing U.P. boy

CALUMET (UPI) — Rewards totaling \$200 are being offered for information that will help locate an 11-year-old Calumet boy, missing for nearly a week.

The family of Karl Heikell is offering a \$100 reward for information that will help authorities find their son. Michigan State Police at the Calumet post are also offering a \$100 reward.

Search parties have turned up no sign of the boy, who was originally considered a runaway. State police said they do not suspect foul play in the disappearance, but are worried that the youngster may have become lost in the woods.

The missing boy is 4-feet-10 and weighs 80 pounds. He has brown hair and blue eyes and was wearing a medium blue jacket and blue jeans when he was last seen at 4 p.m. Saturday in the Calumet area.
